

Checklist for Graduands Attending Convocation (AUGUST 2023 Convocation Batch)

Preparation for Graduation:

Log on to Convocation Portal (https://bit.ly/Convocation_Portal) with your UTAR ID & Password

- Online Pre-Registration (for Venue, date of collection/returning, size etc.) and print/save copy of the confirmation slip. (From 06.07.2023 to 20.07.2023)
- Submission of Convocation online "Application for Refund of Convocation Attire Deposit"
(Deadline: 31.08.2023)
- Payment of Graduation Fee or other outstanding fees such as library fines, car sticker fines
(Deadline: 20.07.2023)
- Online Submission of Gratitude Message (From 06.07.2023 to 10.08.2023)
- Online Verification of Testimonial and Request for Rectification of Testimonial (without charges)
(From 06.07.2023 to 20.07.2023)
- Printing of Testimonial by Graduands (From 06.07.2023 to 31.10.2023)
- Submission of portrait photo for convocation ceremony (Deadline: 20.07.2023)
- UTAR - Graduate Employability Survey: Complete the UTAR Survey form and print /save copy of the survey slip (From 21.07.2023 onwards)

Collection of Convocation Attire, Bar Code Card, Guest Entrance Card & Parking Pass as pre-registered. *

Convocation Day:

- Report and please comply with the convocation dress code for graduands as stated below.
Graduands MUST wear proper convocation attire prior entering the holding room and personal belongings (hand bags, bags, water bottles, flowers, plastic bags etc.) are strictly not allowed to bring into the holding room. UTAR is NOT responsible for any damage or lost items in the room.

After Convocation Day:

Returning of convocation attire according to the venue registered. (On or before 21.08.2023)

- Returning by an Authorized Agent
- A photocopy of the graduand's NRIC;
- A photocopy of his/her agent's NRIC;

- Collection of Souvenir Items (T-shirt & Car Sticker) (Deadline: 31.10.2023)

- Collection of Degree Certificate and Academic Transcript

(* Graduands are to COMPLETE and SIGN the said form in their OWN HANDWRITING. Only ORIGINAL COMPLETED AUTHORISATION FORMS will be accepted)

- A photocopy of the graduand's NRIC;

- A photocopy of his/her agent's NRIC;

- Collection of Stage Photographs (21.08.2023: At the campus which you are registered, 22.08.2023 to 22.11.2023 at UTAR official photographer office)

MALE GRADUANDS



- Dark-Coloured Lounge Suit (Optional)
- Traditional Costume
- Formal Long-Sleeved Shirt with Tie
- Dark-Coloured Formal Shoes

FEMALE GRADUANDS



- Light Coloured Long-Sleeved Blouse/Shirt (with buttons in front)
- Black or Dark-Coloured Jacket (Optional)
- Traditional Costume
- Dark-coloured skirt (at least knee-length or longer length) or long pants
- Black or Dark-Coloured Court Shoes

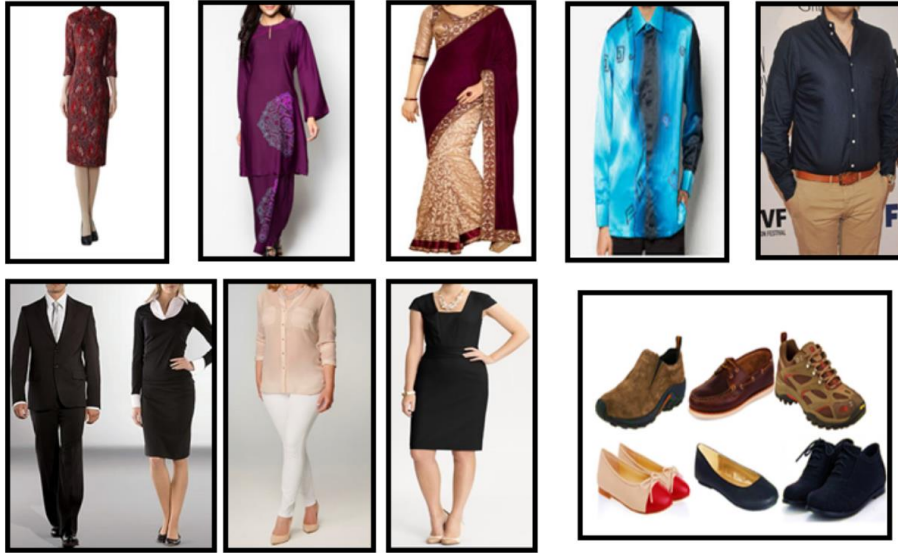
NOT ACCEPTABLE



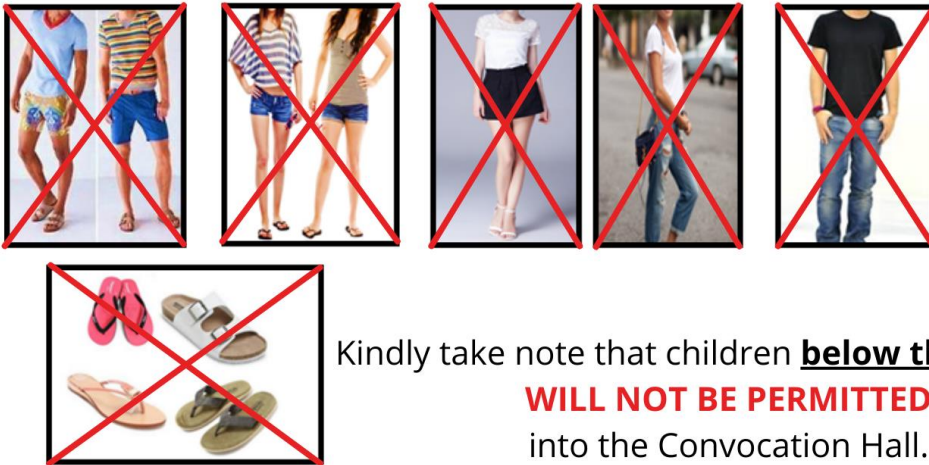
- **Mini skirt**
